

Seismic Public Meeting Notice

To the Citizens and Landowners of Clairborne Parish, Louisiana and Columbia County, Arkansas:

Geokinetics Inc. will be conducting a 3D seismic survey, which is permitted through LDWF and the USACE, to include portions of Claiborne Parish, LA and Columbia County, AR. The project area encompasses 40.08 square miles the towns of Gordon and portions of Haynesville, Louisiana and is centered around the East Haynesville Oil Field. Major roads within and near the project area include US-79, Louisiana 2, and Louisiana 161. US-79 runs north south through Haynesville, known as 1st street while in Haynesville, just inside the project area. Louisiana 2 Alt runs eastward out to Gordon where Louisiana 161 splits and they both leave the project area. The purpose of this survey is to provide a high-resolution image of the subsurface geological features that will allow the client to effectively evaluate the hydrocarbon reserves underlying the project area. The survey requires the deployment of motion sensing devices (geophones or receivers), which would be deployed at regular intervals (220 feet), with spacing between receiver lines of 1,100 feet. The survey design would also incorporate an energy source, which would be placed at regular intervals in a grid pattern.

There will be a public meeting located at Haynesville City Hall Conference Room starting at 6:00 P.M. on March 17, 2015 to answer any questions pertaining to this seismic survey.

The survey will begin March 21, 2015 and last until September 30, 2015.
