2009 YOUTH LOTTERY DEER HUNT PROVISIONS AND REQUIREMENTS

The Louisiana Department of Wildlife and Fisheries will provide deer hunting opportunities for **UP TO 10 YOUTHS ON EACH OF TWO, 2-DAY HUNTS** (Oct. 3-4, 2009 and Oct. 10-11, 2009). Youth hunters will be selected by lottery drawing and will hunt from Department-furnished deer stands on the Point Farm Unit of PACWMA. Selected youth hunters will be allowed to hunt from approximately 2:30 p.m. until ½ hour after official sunset on Saturdays and 5:00 am till 10:00 am Sundays.

Only youths who are under 18 years of age on October 12, 2009 may participate in the hunts. The application to hunt must be completely filled out, including name, address, telephone and social security numbers, and date of birth of the youth applicant. Also, the application must have attached to it a copy of the youth's "hunter safety certification" or "proof of successful completion of a hunter safety course." If the youth has not completed a safety course, he/she is still eligible to participate. However, a copy of the **accompanying** adult supervisor's "hunter safety certification" or "proof of successful completion of hunter safety course" or copy of their "valid hunting license" must be attached to the application. Please provide proof of age for the applicant if their hunter safety certification is not submitted with the application! In addition, attach a \$5.00 administrative fee (check or money order made payable to the Louisiana Department of Wildlife & Fisheries). **This administrative fee is non-refundable.**

Applications that are not totally completed and which do not have all required attachments and fees will not be processed for consideration in the lottery drawing. Only one youth's name on an application – applications must be submitted individually. Only one application per youth -- submission of more than one application for a youth shall disqualify the applicant.

The **completed application**, with the required attachments, **must be received** at the address, below, **by the "close of business" on September 1, 2009.** Following that, a drawing will be held and **successful applicants will be informed by "letter-permit."** **This letter-permit will not be transferable and must be in the hunter's possession while on the area on the days of the hunts.**

Each selected youth hunter **must be accompanied by one (1) adult supervisor, 18 years of age or older.** Adults may not possess a firearm during the hunt. Youth hunters may possess only one legal firearm while hunting. The supervising adult must be within "arms reach" of the youth at all times. The adult may supervise only one (1) youth during the hunt.

2009 YOUTH LOTTERY DEER HUNTS

APPLICATION

The Louisiana Department of Wildlife and Fisheries will provide deer hunting opportunities for youths on two hunts, Oct. 3-4, 2009 and Oct. 10-11, 2009. Youth hunters will be selected by lottery drawing and will hunt from Department-furnished deer stands on the Point Farm Unit of PACWMA. Selected youth hunters will be allowed to hunt from approximately 2:30 p.m. until ½ hour after official sunset on Saturdays and 5:00am till 10:00am Sunday mornings.

REQUIREMENTS

- Provide **ALL OF THE INFORMATION REQUESTED** below and return application to the address, below, **to arrive no later than September 1, 2009.**
- Specify first and second choices of hunt dates. If you can only hunt one of the two dates, only request those dates.
- **Attach** copy of youth's "hunter safety certification" **or** "proof of successful completion of a hunter safety course." If the youth has not completed a safety course, he/she is still eligible to participate. However, a copy of the accompanying adult supervisor's "hunter safety certification" **or** "proof of successful completion of a hunter safety course" **or** copy of "valid hunting license" must be attached to the application.
- **Attach** a \$5.00 check or money order made payable to the Louisiana Dept. of Wildlife & Fisheries (non-refundable administrative fee) to this application.
- **Failure to provide all information, required attachments, or fees will void the application.**
- **Only youths who are under 18 years of age on October 12, 2009 may participate in the hunts.** Please provide proof of age for the applicant if their hunter safety certification is not submitted with the application!
- **Only one (1) youth's name on an application** – applications must be submitted separately.
- **Only one (1) application per youth** – submission of more than one application for a youth shall disqualify the applicant.
- Each selected youth hunter **must be accompanied by one (1) adult supervisor, 18 years of age or older.**
- Youth hunters may possess only one (1) legal firearm while hunting – **adult supervisor may not possess a firearm during the hunt.**
