Region 4 (Iberia)

Region 5 (Cameron and Vermillion)

Vermillion:

- 1-Harvest oysters from unmarked lease
- 1-Failure to display proper number on vessel
- 1-Violate sanitation code (vessel sanitation log)

Region 6: (Terrebonne, Lafourche, Grand Isle)

Lafourche:

- 8 – take oysters from an unapproved area (polluted)
- 5 – harvest oysters illegal hours
- 2 – violate sanitary code (log book)
- 1 – violate sanitary code (vessel refs – tarp)

40 – sacks of oysters seized and returned to the water

Terrebonne:

- 8 - unlawfully take oysters from a private lease
- 8 - fail to have written permission

10 -sacks of oysters seized and returned to the water

Region 8: (Jefferson, Plaquemines, St. Bernard, Orleans, St. Tammany)

- 1-Violate Sanitary Code (Improper Tarp)
