Below are guidelines and information that we ask you to follow and help enforce.

Exhibits & Activities

- Please keep your area trash free. Trash bins are emptied periodically throughout the day.
- No pets allowed.

Set-up

- Set-up begins Friday at 12:00 p.m. Please set-up as much as possible on Friday to eliminate confusion Saturday morning.
- The gates are unlocked at 6:30 a.m. Saturday morning. You must be completely set-up by 8 a.m. Past records show that approximately 300 people arrive before the official 9 a.m. start time.

Registration & Information

- Registration begins at 7:30 a.m. Saturday at the education building. Check in when you arrive.
- Name tags (please wear all day) and t-shirts are distributed at registration.
- Door prizes for volunteers and exhibitors are awarded during the day and names posted at the registration site.
- This site serves as the information booth, and lost and found once registration is finished.

Parking & Traffic

- Parking is very limited and strictly controlled. Please cooperate with our volunteers directing traffic.
- Temporary parking on the grounds is allowed for set-up and unloading but must be removed by 8 am.
- Only vehicles carrying materials, supplies and equipment needed for activities or exhibits to function during the day are allowed to park inside the grounds. All other vehicles should park in the parking lots across from the Waddill entrance.
- Vehicles entering after 8:00 a.m. must have prior approval or obtain approval at the gate from the event coordinators, Marianne Burke or Joel Courtney.
- Traffic during the event is limited to emergency situations only. If you are not staying for the entire event, please park in the lots across from the Waddill entrance at Spiral Metal, AT&T or Victory Bible Academy.

Food

- **No alcoholic beverages.**
- Coca-cola, water, hot dogs and tasting booths are free.
- Jambalaya lunch is served to the volunteers. Lunch carts will come to the exhibitors at lunchtime.
- A drink cart will circulate through the grounds during the day for volunteers.

Music & PA Systems

- In consideration of other exhibitors please do not play music.
- A PA system is available at the site. If you need to make announcements, bring the information to the Registration & Information site at the education building.
