2	Megastructure #1	N 31.19825° W 93.57508°	Large one-piece structure made from 1¼-inch PVC pipe. The structure holds 400 plastic feed pallets.	South Toledo Bend State Park
3	South Toledo Bend State Park Reef #1	N 31.20336° W 93.58069°	50 feed pallet trees located on sloping point. Depth 10-20 ft.	South Toledo Bend State Park
4	South Toledo Bend State Park Reef #2	N 31.20680° W 93.58502°	50 feed pallet trees located in middle of cove. Depth 10-22 ft.	South Toledo Bend State Park
5	Eagle Scout Reef	N 31.27077° W 93.58096°	50 feed pallet trees located on sloping point. Depth 12-20 ft.	Pirate's Cove Marina or Army Recreation Site
6	Pirate's Cove Reef #1	N 31.27168° W 93.58898°	(2) 10 foot long sections of 36-inch diameter PVC pipe. Each section has ½-inch PVC pipe inserted to serve as branches.	Pirate's Cove Marina
7	Negreet Cove #1	N 31.39978° W 93.64785°	(2) 10 foot long sections of 36-inch diameter PVC pipe. Each section has ½-inch PVC pipe inserted to serve as branches.	Cypress Bend, Turtle Beach Landing or Shadows Landing

10	Twin Island Reef	N 31.42738° W 93.69445°	(2) 10 foot long sections of 36-inch diameter PVC pipe. Each section has ½-inch PVC pipe inserted to serve as branches.	Cypress Bend
11	Louisiana end of Pendleton Bridge (Piling numbers 2 - 12)	N 31.48650° W 93.71259°	20 feed pallet trees clustered around base of each set of pilings. Depth 14-24 ft.	Pendleton Bridge Resort or Bridge Bay Resort
12	Louisiana end of Pendleton Bridge Piling number 13	N 31.48557° W 93.71422°	(2) 10 foot long sections of 36-inch diameter PVC pipe. Each section has ½-inch PVC pipe inserted to serve as branches.	Pendleton Bridge Resort or Bridge Bay Resort
13	Louisiana end of Pendleton Bridge (Piling numbers 14 - 19)	N 31.48537° W 93.71457°	(8) 3 foot long sections of 18-inch diameter plastic pipe. Each pipe section is placed in a vertical position.	Pendleton Bridge Resort or Bridge Bay Resort
14	North Toledo Bend State Park Reef #1	N 31.54550° W 93.72945°	100 feed pallet trees located along slope of an underwater ridge. Depth 14-20 ft.	North Toledo Bend State Park
15	North Toledo Bend State Park Reef #2	N 31.54433° W 93.72871°	68 feed pallet trees located along slope of an underwater ridge. Depth 14-24 ft.	North Toledo Bend State Park
16	Clyde's Crossing	N 31.63277° W 93.66662°	23 yards of pea gravel placed around a fishing pier.	Rebecca's Landing
17	Boon's Megastructure	N 31.35968° W 93.64302°	Large one-piece structure made from 1¼-inch PVC pipe. The structure holds 400 plastic feed pallets.	Big Bass Marina or Buckeye Landing
