Eligibility

Only members in good standing with the Coastal Conservation Association, or its youth organization, the New Tide, and who register for the CCA Louisiana Specks and Spots Tournament (SST) and have paid all fees associated therewith shall be eligible to compete in the tournament for prizes. CCA membership is defined as membership in good standing with the Coastal Conservation Association in any state chapter. **CCA memberships of all team members must be valid through June 28, 2014.**

All contestants are required to follow all applicable Federal, State and Local regulations and laws.

At the time of registration, a "captain" must be declared. The captain will be the team member that will receive contact, confirmations and official notices from the tournament.

Registration & Captain's Meeting

Early registration fee is \$150 per team/boat if registered by June 20, 2014 and includes a chance to win a 50qt K2 cooler. Each Captain can register their team online at ccalouisiana.com. Registration will continue until 8:00 p.m. Friday, June 27, 2014, at Quintana Pavilion at Cypremort Point.

Early Kayak registration fee is \$25 per kayak if registered by June 20, 2014 and includes a chance to win a 50qt K2 cooler. Registration will continue until 8:00 p.m. Friday, June 27, 2014, at Quintana Pavilion at Cypremort Point.

The optional pre-tournament check in and captain's meeting will be held at Quintana Pavilion at Cypremort Point on Friday, June 27, 2014 at 6:30 PM. The official ruler and scales will be there for inspection by tournament participants. Rules will be reviewed and questions will be answered by tournament director and weigh master. Each team is encouraged to send at least one representative to the meeting.

Valid tournament entry fees are nonrefundable.

The entire responsibility for valid CCA member status rests solely on the entrant(s). CCA membership must be valid through June 28, 2014 to be eligible for competition in the SST. CCA membership is not included, implied or associated with tournament registration fee. Incorrect, incomplete, illegible or insufficient funds associated with entry forms or memberships will be returned unprocessed and will void entry into the tournament.

Quintana Pavilion at Cypremort Point, Boat Landing on Hwy 319 Friday, June 27, 2014

Pre-tournament check in: 3:00 PM -8:00 PM
Optional Captain's meeting: 6:30 PM

Saturday, June 28, 2014

Launch anywhere, fishing may begin at 6:00 AM
Weigh in: 1:00 PM-3:00 PM. (subject to change). All boats must be checked in with the tournament designee at the end of the canal by 3:00 PM. Any boats not checked in will be automatically disqualified. All contestants must come to check in via boat at the Quintana Pavilion at Cypremort Point. Trailering your boat at another location or bringing your fish by land is prohibited.

Kayaks must be launched and landed at the Cypremort Point state park or boat landing. Kayakers may load their boat and catch on to his/her vehicle, but must drive directly to the Quintana Pavilion for official weigh in. **Kayaks must be human powered vessels only - no trolling motors allowed.**

Permitted Fishing Locations

Tournament waters are defined as coastal waters accessible by a SST contestant's boat, with the exception of areas designated as private impoundments or other waters not legally accessible to the general public. All fish must be landed from the registered boat. No pier, dock, wharf, bank fishing allowed.

Pre-Tournament Practice & Communication

Tournament anglers may scout and fish tournament waters and share information until the point departure for tournament competition. Tournament anglers' communication with anyone except team members, pertaining to fishing, via verbal/non verbal or any other device during the competition period is prohibited.

Other Restrictions

Each boat must have all required safety equipment (specific to size), in serviceable condition, as per U.S. Coast Guard regulations. Boats without factory installed or self-contained fuel reservoirs may only carry fuel in U.S.C.G. approved fuel tanks.

Contestants must use the same boat continuously from the point of tournament embarkation, throughout the tournament to final check in. No boat may be loaded on the trailer before the team's weigh-in except with the permission of the tournament director. All contestants must check in via boat.

Eligible Fish

Specks Division: Two (2) speckled trout (*Cynoscion nebulosus*), 12" or larger shall be entered per team. Tournament standings shall be determined by the aggregate weight measured in pounds and 100ths of a pound of each team's catch during the tournament. The weigh master's decisions shall be final in all matters and are not subject to appeal.

Spots Division: Two (2) Redfish (*Sciaenops ocellatus*), over 16", but less than 27" shall be entered per team. Fish determined to be outside of the slot limit will not be weighed. Tournament standings shall be determined by the aggregate weight measured in pounds and 100ths of a pound of each team's catch during the tournament. The weigh master's decisions shall be final in all matters and are not subject to appeal.

Fish will be measured with mouth closed and with the tail pinched. The measurement will be from the tip of the snout to the extreme tip of the tail fin. All fish will be measured only once.

No mutilated fish shall be accepted. No angler may manipulate the weight or length of any fish entered for competition at any time during or prior to the tournament.

Live Weigh In Raffle

Louisiana Department of Wildlife and Fisheries will host a live weigh-in for Speckled Trout and Redfish. Each angler is allowed to weigh in multiple fish between 1:00-3:00 PM. Each successful live weigh in will receive a raffle ticket for a K2 Cooler.

Polygraphs

Each contestant agrees, by registering for the tournament, to submit to a polygraph examination and abide by its conclusion. The SST Committee reserves the right to select polygraphists to administer polygraph examinations.

Bait and Tackle

Artificial lures, live, or dead bait may be used. All fish entered into competition for prizes must have been caught and landed by the contestant on conventional rod, hook and line exclusively.

Tie Breakers

In the event of two teams having the identical weight, the ties shall be broken by the team with the earliest weigh in time.

Safety

VHF channel 69 will be the SST channel.

Each contestant, in each team is required to follow all Wildlife and Fisheries and U.S.C.G rules and regulations. All contestants are highly encouraged to properly wear U.S.C.G. approved P.F.D. (life jacket) when the main (combustion) engine is operating.

Each boat is highly encouraged to have an operational ignition kill switch attached to the driver's body when the combustion engine is operating.

VHF channel 16 should be used to hail other vessels and officials in case of an emergency. Report any and all accidents and emergencies involving contestants to SST Headquarters as soon as applicable.

Youth Division

Contestants under the age of 18 must fish with a parent or designated guardian on a registered boat or accompanied in a kayak. They are not eligible to compete alone. Youth Anglers can enter a fish in the youth division only if they personally caught the fish. Their fish may be used for the Boat/Team or Kayak competition also.

Louisiana Department of Wildlife and Fisheries will provide Adults with one raffle ticket for each youth they register. Raffle prize include coolers, chairs, and tackle and will be drawn after the weigh in.

RELEASE, HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNITY: IN CONSIDERATION OF BEING ALLOWED TO ENTER THE CCA LOUISIANA SPECKS AND SPOTS TOURNAMENT, EACH PERSON AGREES AND CONTRACTS TO RELEASE, INDEMNIFY AND HOLD HARMLESS THE COASTAL CONSERVATION ASSOCIATION, ITS AGENTS, OFFICERS, DIRECTORS, EMPLOYEES, REPRESENTATIVES, THE TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR, INCLUDING INDEMNITY FOR ANY NEGLIGENT ACTS OR OMISSIONS OF THE FOREGOING RELEASED AND INDEMNIFIED PARTIES, FROM ANY AND ALL LIABILITY, CLAIMS, OR DAMAGES ARISING OUT OF OR IN ANY MANNER WHATSOEVER CONNECTED WITH THE PLANNING, OPERATION OR CONDUCT OF THE TOURNAMENT, AND INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO CLAIMS FOR PERSONAL INJURY, WRONGFUL DEATH, SURVIVAL DAMAGES, PROPERTY DAMAGE, OR CLAIMS RELATING IN ANY WAY TO THE AWARDED OF PRIZES IN THE TOURNAMENT. THE PARENT OR LEGAL REPRESENTATIVE OF ANY MINOR ENTERING IN, REGISTERING FOR OR FISHING IN THE TOURNAMENT DOES FURTHER CONTRACT AND AGREE FOR THEMSELVES AND ON BEHALF OF SAID MINOR THAT THIS RELEASE AND HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT SHALL BE BINDING UPON ANY MINOR ENTERING THE TOURNAMENT. WINNERS WILL BE REQUIRED TO EXECUTE AN ADDITIONAL RELEASE, INDEMNITY AND HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT UPON RECEIPT OF PRIZE. ANY CONTROVERSY, CLAIM OR DISPUTE ARISING OUT OF OR IN ANY WAY RELATING TO THE TOURNAMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY BINDING ARBITRATION CONDUCTED IN THE CITY OF BATON ROUGE, EAST BATON ROUGE PARISH, LOUISIANA, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE COMMERCIAL ARBITRATION RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. JUDGMENT ON THE AWARD RENDERED BY THE ARBITRATOR MAY BE ENTERED BY A COURT OF COMPETENT JURISDICTION IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE LAW. SHOULD LITIGATION AND/OR ARBITRATION RESULT BETWEEN A PARTICIPANT AND CCA LOUISIANA, IT IS AGREED THAT IF CCA LOUISIANA IS THE PREVAILING PARTY IN SUCH LITIGATION AND/OR ARBITRATION, CCA LOUISIANA SHALL BE ENTITLED TO RECOVER REASONABLE ATTORNEYS FEES AND ALL COSTS INCURRED IN THE ARBITRATION AND/OR LITIGATION FROM THE OTHER PARTY TO SAID ARBITRATION AND/OR LITIGATION.
