To participate in the lottery teal hunts on the White Lake property, applications must be completed and received in Room 422 of the Department of Wildlife and Fisheries building by close of business August 15, 2013. Mailing address is: Department of Wildlife and Fisheries, Attention: White Lake Teal Hunt at P. O. Box 98000, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, 70898. Applicants must be 18 years of age or older. Hunters may submit only one application for the season. Submission of more than one application per hunter will result in disqualification of the applicant. **The Louisiana Department of Wildlife and Fisheries does not guarantee these hunts and therefore reserves the right to cancel any or all scheduled hunts should environmental conditions (Act of God, insufficient water levels, etc.) deem it necessary.**

A \$5.00 administrative fee will be charged for each application. Applications must be accompanied by a check or money order made payable to the Louisiana Department of Wildlife and Fisheries. This administrative fee is non-refundable.

This form is an application for a hunting area on the White Lake property. Each area will accommodate a maximum of 2 hunters. Successful applicants will be allowed to bring one (1) additional licensed hunter as his guest provided that the guest has not been drawn for another date and has not or will not be attending another White Lake Teal Lottery hunt during the 2013 season. Successful applicants will be notified by mail and will be required to submit an additional check or money order for \$250.00 (\$125.00 per gun) to the Louisiana Department of Wildlife and Fisheries. Hunt permits are non-transferable. In the event the applicant is not able to participate on the date selected, he or she should notify the Department and the Department will attempt to fill the slot with a hunter from an alternate list. Applicants can only be selected for one hunt for the 2013 White Lake Teal Lottery however you can request multiple dates from the dates listed below to optimize your chances of being drawn.

**WHITE LAKE WETLANDS CONSERVATION AREA
WATERFOWL (TEAL) LOTTERY HUNTS
RULES AND REGULATIONS**

The Louisiana Department of Wildlife and Fisheries has established a lottery waterfowl (teal) hunt on White Lake property that has the potential to provide excellent waterfowl hunting. Hunts will be restricted to persons selected by a lottery and will be limited to 2 persons/unit. All hunters will hunt as a group with a guide. No splitting up will be allowed. The primary purpose of these hunts is to provide a quality experience. Strict adherence to the following rules and regulations will be required to ensure a safe and enjoyable hunt.

1. **SAFETY IS FIRST AND FOREMOST IN EVERYONE'S MIND. NO LOADED FIREARMS EXCEPT WHILE HUNTING IN THE BLIND. HOWEVER, A HUNTER WILL BE ALLOWED TO CARRY A LOADED FIREARM OUTSIDE THE BLIND TO DISPATCH AND RETRIEVE WOUNDED WATERFOWL. TAKE EVERY PRECAUTION TO HAVE A SAFE AND ENJOYABLE HUNT.**
2. Selected participants must arrive at the designated site by 5:00 AM. Anyone arriving after 5:00 AM will not be allowed to enter the area. Hunting will end no later than 9:00 AM.
3. Guides and hunt area (blind) will be assigned the morning of the hunt.
4. Access will be provided to a designated parking area. Transportation from the parking area to the site will be provided.
5. Each hunter shall have appropriate licenses (basic license, state duck stamp, federal duck stamp and HIP certification) prior to arrival. **NO LICENSES WILL BE AVAILABLE AT THE HUNTING SITE.** Licenses will be checked at time of arrival.
6. Legal firearms, as specified in the hunting regulations pamphlet, except no 10 gauge shotguns will be allowed.
7. Persons engaging in "sky busting" will be asked to leave.
8. No dogs will be allowed.
9. Hunters will be responsible for removing **all litter** from the area and surrounding areas.
10. No alcoholic beverages will be permitted on the premises.
