

## 2017 WILDLIFE DIVISION PUBLIC LAKES LOTTERY ALLIGATOR HARVEST APPLICANT SUCCESS RATES

The following table reports the percentage of applicants in 2017 that were selected (applicant success rates) through a random drawing to participate in lottery alligator harvests on public lakes. There is no guarantee that future applicant success rates will be similar to those in 2017 or that the public lakes listed below will be available for future lottery alligator harvests. The information presented below is for informational purposes only and designed to assist potential lottery alligator harvest applicants.
