Deer Management Objective (Circle one) - Indicates hunter's desired harvest objectives for the enrolled property.

Tier 1: 1,000 ac or more, associated with quality or trophy buck management. Strategies include increased doe harvest to maintain deer herds at balanced levels and allowing bucks to reach older ages before harvest. Mandatory antlered & antlerless tags required along with complete harvest data collection.

Tier 2: 500 ac or more, associated with quality deer management. Complete harvest data collection required. Only Antlerless tags normally issued.

Tier 3: 40 ac or more, documentation of total number of antlered and antlerless deer required. Only antlerless tags available.

Tier 4: No acreage minimum, documentation of total number of antlered and antlerless deer required. Only available for nuisance deer issues such as crop or lawn depredation. Only antlerless tags issued.

DMAP fees must be paid by mail to the Louisiana Department of Wildlife and Fisheries Fiscal Section in Baton Rouge before September 15.

I further certify and agree that:

- The boundaries of this property are clearly marked and posted with DMAP signs in compliance with LAC 76: V.111 (Attached).
- That each hunter will have a DMAP tag in his possession while hunting antlerless deer, or antlered deer if antlered tags are issued and a numbered DMAP tag shall be affixed to the hock of all antlerless deer taken or antlered deer if antlered tags are issued, in such a manner that it cannot be removed before the deer is transported. Additionally, the tag will remain on the carcass until the animal is butchered and packaged for storage
- The Cooperator is responsible for daily documentation of mandatory deer kill information on an official LDWF data sheet. These records must be made available within 48 hours upon request from LDWF personnel. I agree to submit these records annually to the Department of Wildlife and Fisheries by March 1.
- By enrolling in DMAP, the cooperator agrees to allow Department personnel access to their lands for management surveys, investigation of violations and other inspections deemed appropriate by the Department.
- I understand that failure to comply with the terms of this agreement as set forth above and in the Rules and Regulations of the Deer Management Assistance Program, LAC 76:V.111 may result in suspension and cancellation of the program on those lands involved.
