As per L.R.S. 56:699.5, active or veteran members of the United States armed services, POST-certified law enforcement officers, or current POST-certified persons may apply for an exemption to the Louisiana hunter education certification requirements. To apply for this exemption, please return the following to the address below:

1. This form, completed and signed;
2. A copy of your driver's license;
3. For law enforcement – a copy of your current post-certification card;
4. For military – a copy of your DD214 or active duty ID.

Upon approval, you will receive a Military/Police Hunter Education Exemption Card.
