Grade Levels: 6th-8th; 10th-12th

Our wetlands are disappearing at an alarming rate. Learn how vital our Louisiana Wetlands are to humans and animals alike. Gain an understanding of some of the primary sources of wetlands loss and what we can do to restore and conserve them. Meet animals that are affected by human impacts including habitat loss, over-hunting, pollution, and introduction of invasive species.
