Description: Discharge of Process Water From a Sand and Gravel Mining Pit

This permit is issued by authority of Part II of Chapter 8, Title 56 of the LRS of 1950 as amended and re-enacted regarding the Louisiana Natural & Scenic Rivers System and the administrative procedures pertaining to the management of these watercourses designated as Scenic Rivers.

The permit is issued by the Administrator with the understanding that the recipient in implementation of the proposal will proceed in compliance with, and not significantly deviate from the provisions contained in the petition for the permit and any special conditions attached hereto. The permit holder is expected to minimize adverse impacts to the structural and functional integrity of the natural systems and aesthetics associated with the Scenic River where the activity is occurring so as to preserve the fundamental character and purpose for which the System was established.

The Administrator assumes no responsibility for or incurs no liability for any injury to persons or property caused by any act of the permit holder or his agent in the permission granted by this permit. In addition to the Department of Wildlife & Fisheries, the petition was given a full and thorough evaluation by the Louisiana Departments of Agriculture & Forestry; Culture, Recreation & Tourism; Environmental Quality; and the Office of State Planning and Budget. If during the review process objections were made to the proposed activity, those objections were either found to be insignificant or they have been included in the conditions of the permit.

This permit shall expire if the permitted activity has not begun within 18 months of the "Issue Date" indicated above.

Compliance with these conditions is necessary for this permit to be valid:

General Conditions:

- 1) All other applicable permits not contingent upon this permit from governmental entities will be acquired and their conditions implemented with fidelity. Applicant has title to the property or permission from the landowner to implement the project.
- 2) If during project activity, any sensitive archaeological, biological or botanical element is encountered, activity will temporarily cease and the permit holder will contact the Administrator to determine the disposition of that element or artifact.
- 3) This project must be carried out in a manner consistent with the design that the applicant submitted during the permit process and as depicted in the attached plats. Should significant physical modification to the project become necessary during implementation of the project or after its completion, the permit holder will submit a letter of explanation within one week of discovery to the Administrator to determine if another petition will be required.
- 4) Any authorization issued under the authority of this permit may not be transferred to another party without giving prior notice to the Scenic Rivers Program Coordinator.
- 5) The permittee shall allow representatives of LDWF to make periodic inspections to ensure the activity being performed is in accordance with the conditions of this permit.

Special Operating Conditions:

- 1) This permit only addresses process water and stormwater discharges; any mining expansion riverward of the current operation will require explicit authorization.
- 2) The permittee shall ensure that all contractors, subcontractors, and workers are made fully aware of the limits of the work authorized by this permit and adhere to and comply with all conditions listed in this Scenic River permit. Non-compliance with permit terms and conditions may result in permit suspension or revocation.
- 3) This permit does not authorize any type of water withdrawal from the Amite River. Any withdrawal of water from the Amite River shall require a separate determination from LDWF.
- 4) The applicant shall contact LDWF prior to the release of any process water. At that time LDWF will evaluate current river conditions, process water sample data, expected duration of release, and any other data deemed essential to management decisions. Releases shall only occur at LDWF's discretion.
- 5) Effluent limitations established for *process wastewater and process area stormwater discharges to*

designated outstanding natural resource waters and their tributaries by LDEQ Master Permit LAG490000 must be adhered to for this permit to remain valid. Furthermore, LDWF shall be supplied a copy of all Discharge Monitoring Reports (DMR) and other reporting submitted to LDEQ in accordance with LAG490000. Non-compliance with LAG490000 terms and conditions may result in permit suspension or revocation.


- 6) If effluent limitations are exceeded a corrective action plan outlining measures taken to reduce pollution levels must be submitted to LDWF within 15 days of discovery.
- 7) At closure of the mining operation, prior to ceasing operations and removing equipment, LDWF shall be allowed a site inspection and the applicant may be required to take specific actions to ensure that pit conditions do not result in continued discharges or other impacts to the Amite River.
- 8) This permit only grants authorization for Regional Sand and Gravel, LLC to discharge water from the mining pit. No other entity is granted authorization for a discharge of water from the mining pit at any time during or post-mining operations. Regional shall inform the landowner of this requirement.


