

Dear Scenic River Permit Applicant:

Please review and concur on the following statement regarding the issuance of permits by the Louisiana Department of Wildlife and Fisheries. This agreement must be signed and returned before a Scenic River Permit can be issued.

"I have been advised and do understand that by applying for and accepting a Scenic Rivers permit issued by the Louisiana Department of Wildlife and Fisheries, I am being allowed to engage in an activity which would otherwise be prohibited by law or for which a permit is required. I understand that the permit is not a license and confers no property right upon me. I specifically agree to abide by all State and Federal fish and wildlife laws and regulations, and all State and Federal laws and regulations which relate to this permit or the permitted activity, and by all other terms and conditions of this permit. I understand that the permit for which I am applying may be suspended, annulled, withdrawn or revoked and that I may be assessed civil penalties, all in accordance with the provision of the Louisiana Administrative Procedure Act, and that I may be denied future permits as a consequence of my failure to fully and completely comply with the terms and conditions of the permit, as well as other laws and regulations pertinent thereto. If served with or notified of a cease and desist order signed by the Scenic Rivers Administrator, I agree to immediately and without delay cease all activities and operations which relate to the permitted activity or which are impacting the Scenic River, until such time as the matter can be resolved in an adjudicatory hearing pursuant to the Louisiana Administrative Procedure Act. I understand and agree that any permit issued to me by the Louisiana Department of Wildlife and Fisheries is in the nature of a privilege which is being voluntarily extended to me by the Department and the failure on my part to cooperate with the Department can result in the loss of the privilege conferred and the denial of future requests for permits. By accepting this permit, I evidence my agreement to be bound by all conditions and stipulations set forth herein."

-DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT

Construction of a residential camp and boatshed for recreational use on lot H11 and H12 on the Tangipahoa River. All access to this location is by water and boat only. The boatshed is 30'x20' and will be connected by a 4' walkway to the camp. The camp will be 24'x24' and around 13' off the ground. No creosote products will be used in any part of this project. See attached diagrams.

-ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT

1. EXISTING CONDITIONS

Proposed building site is located on a typical river bank environment on a 75' wide x roughly 120' deep lot.

2. JUSTIFICATION

The request to construct a camp and boatshed for recreational use of the property by the owner. The structure will provide increased access to the water providing boat mooring, fishing opportunities, and increase overall enjoyment of the environment without causing erosion.

3. IMPACTS

- a. **EXISTING LAND USE:** Currently the property has no structures or improvements. All plans are aimed towards recreational use.
- b. **HISTORICAL / ARCHEOLOGICAL SITES:** NO IMPACT. No known sites of this type exist on the property.
- c. **ECONOMIC IMPACT OF THE PROJECT:** NO IMPACT. Construction will not conflict with any commercial use of the river or any property in the area. It will not be a hazard to boat traffic because the boat shed will not go any further into the river than existing sheds nearby.
- d. **WILDERNESS / RURAL QUALITY:** NO IMPACT. The project is consistent with other structures in the local area.
- e. **SCENIC / AESTHETIC VALUE:** NO IMPACT. The camp and boat shed will be sturdy and of quality construction. The location and materials used will ensure it blends well with the environment.
- f. **RECREATIONAL USE / OPPORTUNITIES:** POSITIVE IMPACT. It will provide increase access to the water to include fishing, boat mooring as well as other uses.
- g. **ECOLOGICAL SYSTEM PRESENT:** NO IMPACT. There are not any nests, dens, or any other signs of habitation of wildlife on the site. Construction will not restrict any if they occur.
- h. **FISH AND WILDLIFE IN THE AREA:** NO IMPACT. Wildlife will not be denied access to the river or surrounding area.
- i. **BOTANICAL ELEMENTS (VEGITATION):** One Gum tree is to be removed to allow construction of the camp.
- j. **GEOLOGICAL FEATURES:** NO IMPACT. No mining or extraction of any substance takes place on the site.
- k. **HYDROLOGICAL FEATURES:** NO IMPACT. Construction will not cause any canalization, channel realignment, or impoundment of water.

i. WATER QUALITY/QUANTITY: NO IMPACT. Construction will not contaminate or restrict water flow in any way.

-LISTING OF STEPS TO MINIMIZE AND OR OFFSET POTENTIAL IMPACTS

1. No creosote treated wood or any other toxic materials will be used in any part of construction.
2. Place nothing other than pilings in water to prevent restriction of water flow.
3. Keep height of construction to a minimum to prevent blocking view of the river.
4. Will use temporary mat to install pilings.
5. Will use sound construction methods and quality materials to ensure scenic quality.

No alternatives. there would be no construction of the camp and wharf.



H-10




High Water

120' to opposite Bank


