Dear Scenic River Permit Applicant:

Please review and concur on the following statement regarding the issuance of permits by the Louisiana Department of Wildlife and Fisheries. This agreement must be signed and returned before a Scenic River Permit can be issued.

"I have been advised and do understand that by applying for and accepting a Scenic Rivers permit issued by the Louisiana Department of Wildlife and Fisheries, I am being allowed to engage in an activity which would otherwise be prohibited by law or for which a permit is required. I understand that the permit is not a license and confers no property right upon me. I specifically agree to abide by all State and Federal fish and wildlife laws and regulations, and all State and Federal laws and regulations which relate to this permit or the permitted activity, and by all other terms and conditions of this permit. I understand that the permit for which I am applying may be suspended, annulled, withdrawn or revoked and that I may be assessed civil penalties, all in accordance with the provision of the Louisiana Administrative Procedure Act, and that I may be denied future permits as a consequence of my failure to fully and completely comply with the terms and conditions of the permit, as well as other laws and regulations pertinent thereto. If served with or notified of a cease and desist order signed by the Scenic Rivers Administrator, I agree to immediately and without delay cease all activities and operations which relate to the permitted activity or which are impacting the Scenic River, until such time as the matter can be resolved in an adjudicatory hearing pursuant to the Louisiana Administrative Procedure Act. I understand and agree that any permit issued to me by the Louisiana Department of Wildlife and Fisheries is in the nature of a privilege which is being voluntarily extended to me by the Department and the failure on my part to cooperate with the Department can result in the loss of the privilege conferred and the denial of future requests for permits. By accepting this permit, I evidence my agreement to be bound by all conditions and stipulations set forth herein."

Scenic Rivers – Environmental Assessment

Project Description: Proposal to stabilize river bank from erosion into property which serves as the foundation for a residential camp/house. Stabilization will be completed by installing silt mix, concrete rocks 12-16 “ in size free from any construction debris, geotextile fabric, and vegetation seeds.

1. Existing Land Use

The land is owned by myself, Dylan Johnson, and is used for recreational activities. The land and home/private residence were passed onto me by my father, Tommy Johnson, after he passed away in January, 2021. The land was developed and residence built years prior to my father purchasing the property in 2015.

2. Wilderness Qualities

The project will have no negative impact on wilderness qualities. No tree clearing or bank line changes will occur, only reinforcing the bank with concrete rocks. The area surrounding the river bank consists of heavily wooded areas including the opposite side of the river which contains a sand bar. This project will not change the surrounding area.

3. Scenic/Aesthetic Values

The scenic values will not be impacted by the proposed project. There will not be any changes to the surrounding vegetation or landscape. Water flow will not necessary be changed but rather prevented from continuing to erode into the existing homes foundation.

4. Ecological Regimes

The project will not have any effect on the river’s ecological function and no permanent changes will be made to the flow, function or connectivity of the river.

5. Recreational Use/Opportunities

This is a private residential site and I alone have access.

6. Fish and Other Aquatic Life

Fish and other aquatic life will not be negatively impacted by the proposed project. No concrete rock will be placed into the waterway itself, only the upper bank line to reinforce from erosion during high flood periods.

7. Wildlife

There will be no clearing of vegetation or wildlife habitat during this project. Wildlife will continue to have access to the river and banks.

8. Historical and Archaeological Resources

To the best of our knowledge, no historical or archaeological resources of significance occur on the property.

9. Geological Resources

To the best of our knowledge, no geological resources adjacent to the river will be changed by the proposed project.

10. Botanical Resources

The native vegetation will not be negatively impacted by this project. There is no need to clear or remove any existing vegetation. This project may actually improve the vegetation by preventing erosion of the river bank trees and other foliage.

11. Water Quality and Quantity

The water quality of the river will not be affected by this project. No concrete rock reinforcement will be placed into the river itself, only the high portions of the bank.

12. Hydrologic Features

Local hydrology should not be negatively impacted by the proposed project. About 3 times a year the river floods to a degree that reaches over the riverbank just in front of the property. The bank was reinforced with concrete when the previous owner built the property many years ago but it has finally failed and water is eroding into the bank which I fear will soon reach the foundation which the home sits on.

13. Cultural Resources

There are no known cultural resources associated with this project.

14. Economic Impact of Project

This project should not have any negative impact on the local economy. There will be some benefit to the local supplier of concrete as well as the continued enjoyment of the property and its access to the beautiful Bogue Chitto River.

Steps to Minimize and/or Offset Potential Impacts to the River


This project will allow myself and family to continue accessing and enjoying the nature and beauty of the Bogue Chitto River. I fear that if erosion continues, the entire foundation of the house will become compromised and the house may collapse. I hope to prevent this by reinforcing the river bank with appropriate materials which will have little to no negative impacts to the river's health and natural beauty nor to the local wild life.

Alternatives

I am unaware of any alternatives to this project other than to wait and let nature takes its course which I fear will be the collapse of the home built on the property.

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
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Birds eye view
