

OYSTER IMPORTATION APPLICATION

LDWF allows oyster imports from the northern Gulf of America ONLY. Filing an application does NOT guarantee approval. Permits are issued on a case-by case-basis. Applicants will be notified in writing of the Department's decision. If approved, permit issuance may take up to 10 business days after all required documents are received. Permit holders must notify the Department at least two business days prior to each importation event. A copy of the permit and all accompanying permit documents must be kept with the oysters being imported throughout transport or delivery.
