

Steps to obtain Charterboat Captain's License (OUPV, "6-pack") with the United States Coast Guard

Beginning November 15, 2021 all Freshwater Charter Boat Captains are required to have a license to operate. LA Department of Wildlife & Fisheries will begin requiring proof of insurance and a USCG captain's license at the point of purchase on November 15, 2022.


The information below is to aid in obtaining the USCG captain's license:

- Application for Merchant Mariner Credential (MMC)
- Application for Medical Certificate (Physical Exam)
- Periodic Drug Testing Form
- Sea Service Form



OUPV captains can complete their physical and drug screening at the same locations which assist offshore workers.

After all courses/exam are complete and documents are received, a Merchant Mariner Credential (MMC) is issued.
