- (4) I agree to allow inspection of property by authorized employees of the Louisiana Department of Wildlife and Fisheries during normal business hours.
- (5) I acknowledge that it is unlawful to release captive native turtles into the wild or transfer possession of native turtles except to the Louisiana Department of Wildlife and Fisheries or their designated agent.

Under the authority of Section G of LAC 76:XV.101, the applicant is hereby granted a temporary exemption to possess native turtles as specified above until those individuals expire.

The following conditions apply to this permit:

- It is unlawful to commercially take, possess, sell, purchase, trade, barter, exchange, import, or export native turtles, their eggs, or any parts thereof, or attempt to commercially take, possess, sell, purchase, trade, barter, exchange, import, or export native turtles, their eggs, or any parts thereof.
- Any person in possession of prohibited native turtles or exceeding the limit of restricted native turtles shall have until July 19, 2025 to register those native turtles in their possession with LDWF, in order to retain the registered animals for the life of said animals.
- Permits for registered native turtles shall expire on December 31 and must be renewed annually within 30 days of expiration.
- Captive breeding activities and collection of native turtle eggs is prohibited unless approved and permitted by LDWF.
