Seismic Public Meeting Notice

To the Citizens and Landowners of Tensas Parish Louisiana

Geokinetics Inc. will be conducting seismic activity in a 75 square mile area, and the area is west of the town of Newellton. The project covers the Buckhorn Wildlife Management Area and is south and east of Tensas River and approximately 2 miles west of US Hwy. 65. The project is located In Township 13 North, Range 10 East; Township 13 North, Range 11 East; Township 12 North, Range 10 East; and Township 12 North, Range 11 East. The purpose of the survey is to provide a high-resolution image of the subsurface geological features that will allow effective evaluation of possible hydrocarbon reserves underlying the project area. The survey will require the deployment of motion sensing devices (geophones) which would be deployed at regular intervals (220 feet), with spacing between geophone lines of 1,320 feet. The survey design would also incorporate an energy source, which would be placed at regular intervals in a grid pattern.

There will be a public meeting located at the St. Joseph Community Center at 107 Arts Drive, US Hwy 65 St. Joseph LA. starting at 6 P. M. on June 14 to answer any questions pertaining to this seismic survey.
