If you build it they will come.



BACKGROUND/HISTORY

- > Built in 1958; 2,200 acres
- > Water supply for International Paper Mill
- > Located in Morehouse Parish
- > Problem: degraded habitat, fisheries declined, fisheries were not a priority
- Donated to LDWF in 2013














RENOVATION

- > Purpose: provide a high-quality fishery
- Major projects:
- Drawdown
- Boat lanes
- Wave breaks
- New water pump
- Removal of undesirable fish species
- Boat dock and fishing piers (partnered with MITA for kids pier)
- Stocking desirable forage and sportfish species
- Restrooms
- > Funded by Sport Fish Restoration \$\$








RESULTS

- > Two Major League Fishing tournaments
- > National destination, boost in local economy
- Big fish
 - Two top-ten record crappie
 - Trophy bass (including the current #8 state record)
- > Average attendance per year
- 5,500 visits
